

Zoetendal Wines is situated 3km from the historical village of Elim and 20km from the southernmost tip of Africa – where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet.

The unique terroir sets all wines from the Elim ward in a class of their own. The coastal climate enables the grapes to mature slowly, distinguishing rich and intense flavours.

As well as being a member of the 20-plus local landowners engaged in environmental rehabilitation, conservation and protection via the Nuwejaars Wetland Special Management Area (SMA), Zoetendal also forms part of a pioneering initiative aimed at developing a

sustainable ecology in harmony with commercially viable farming. The SMA has released 15 Buffalo, 5 Hippo, 47 Eland, 21 Red Hartebeest and 21 Bontebok on these farms.

The cool sea breeze in Elim tempers Zoetendal's vibrant Sauvignon Blanc with the perfect balance of low pH, high acidity and a touch of residual sugar, finishing with subtle minerality. New release vintage is a single vineyard Shiraz, making this terroir-driven Shiraz a cut above the rest.

Zoetendal enjoys an IPW and BWI accreditation.
